Mon., Apr. 24 - Eugene City Council Public Testimony - More roads and cars, or... cleaner transit & walkable neighborhood options?

What kind of Transportation System Plan do YOU think Eugene should pass? One that considers our commitment to reducing our greenhouse gas emissions based on science and our Climate Recovery Ordinance, right?

Let the councilors know that we want a plan that incorporates qualifiable targets for reaching our benchmarks.

Eugene’s adopted goal: reduce community wide use of fossil fuels by 50% by 2030 and GHS by 7.6% per year. Part of how we get there is by funding and building infrastructure for better transit, more bike & pedestrian routes and limited road expansions.
